

South Texas PHRF Meeting Minutes 5:00 p.m., 18 August 2022

The meeting was called to order at 5:00 p.m. on 18 August 2022. Members Rick Bell, Doug Weakly and Jim Robertson were present. Robertson's attendance was by speakerphone out of concern he might be contagious from a recent mild tussle with COVID.

There were no corrections or additions to the minutes of the previous meeting on 29 March 2022.

Old Business

ST PHRF By-Laws and Fleet Handbook revisions. Chairman Bell has sent draft copies to committee members for review and markup. Requested updates / comments / proposed revisions by mid-September.

New Business

PHRF Review	1981 C&C 34 Leprechaun.	Request from owner	Jim Connor fo	r assignment of

provisional ST PHRF rating. C&C 34 class has a base rating of 144 sec/mi. *Leprechaun* has a 105% headsail and a two-bladed fixed propeller. **D. Weakly moved to assign** provisional rating of 153 based on 144 sec/mi base plus 6 for small jib and 3 for prop.

Total 153. Seconded by Robertson and approved.

PHRF Review 1982 Catalina 25 *Migration*. Request from owner Donald Muir for assignment of

provisional ST PHRF rating. Catalina 25 class has a base rating of 228 sec/mi.

Everything on *Migration* is standard, including a 150% headsail. **D. Weakly moved to**

assign provisional rating of 228 sec/mi. Seconded by Robertson and approved.

PHRF Review 1981 J-30 ODR Ciao. Request from owner Daniel Willias for new-owner review of

rating. Current rating 141 sec/mi which Daniel believes was because the boat's spinnaker pole is 109% of J. Sails and other equipment all standard, including 155%

genoa. Folding prop. Base PHRF for this class is 144. The oversized pole is ODR

compliant. Rick Bell moved to assign provisional rating of 144. The oversize pole is a

one design requirement and should not be penalized. Seconded by Weakly and approved.

PHRF Review

2003 Catalina 400 Mk II Gypsy Rover. Request from owner Bill Downey for provisional ST PHRF rating. This boat is a sister ship to Steve Indrelunas' *Independence* which has a PHRF of 126 sec/mi with a 110% foresail. Gypsy Rover has a 130% foresail. Deduct 3 sec/mi from *Independence* rating because of the larger foresail on *Gypsy* Rover. Rick Bell motioned to assign a provisional rating of 123 sec/mi. Seconded by Robertson and approved.
